

Crowdmark for Online Courses FAQ

Can I use Administered Assessments?

No, administered assessments are for face-to-face only. Assigned Assessments are intended for remote assignments and midterms.

Can I use Crowdmark for multiple choice questions?

No, not in an automated way. The multiple choice feature is a bubble sheet intended for face-to-face classes. You won't be able to use it for online classes. You could still ask MC questions, but it won't be automated grading. Students would write the answer on a piece of paper. Try D2L Brightspace for an automated multiple choice system.

Do I have to upload my questions separately one by one?

No, for a shortcut you could upload all your questions in a single document to the Assignment Description, then add the same number of questions, for each question write "See Question #1 in attached file."

Do students have to upload their questions as separate files?

No, but it is preferred if their questions are answered on separate pages of paper.

They can upload all of their answers as one file and drag each page to the appropriate answer field.

What file types can student's submit?

PDF, JPEG

Can I have multiple versions of the same test?

Yes, you would need to create multiple Assigned Assessments and then add a custom group of students to each assessment rather than adding the entire class list to the assessment. Can I change the lateness penalty to hours instead of days?

No. The lateness penalty is applied the second the assignment is late. If you want to apply your own lateness penalty you can see the submission times for each student and deduct points at your own discretion.
